RECOMMENDATION

Commission staff recommend review and decision on the above-mentioned licenses applying for renewal, and if approved, request that the approval be subject to the licensee remaining in compliance with the Commission regulations and applicable law.

In addition to the above condition, the following conditions apply individually to the named licensees:

- 1. Pharmacannis Massachusetts, Inc. (MR281252)
 - a. Within 60 days, the licensee is required to submit a progress report on its ongoing compliance with its Positive Impact Plan.
- 2. M3 Ventures, Inc. (MC281446/MP281346/MR281290)
 - a. Within 60 days, the licensee is required to submit revised goals for its diversity plan that individually apply to certain diverse categories of individuals instead of establishing a goal for "women, minorities, veterans, people with disabilities, people of all gender identities and sexual orientations" as a group.
- 3. I.N.S.A., Inc. (MC281268/MP281246/MR281680)
 - a. Within 60 days, the licensee is required to submit its progress on the following items that were set in its original Diversity Plan:
 - i. Update of the workforce utilization report;
 - ii. Update on diversity officer;
 - iii. Update on mandatory trainings (diversity awareness, cultural competence, LGBTQ awareness);
 - iv. Update on periodic wage review;
 - v. Update on mentoring program and career counseling;
 - vi. Update on senior management evaluations of company-wide performance on diversity; and
 - vii. Update on plans to work with the NAACP, UnidosUS, Organization for Chinese-Americans, National Society of Black Engineers, Society for Hispanic Engineers, and the Society of Women Engineers.
- 4. Alternative Therapies Group, Inc. (MR281255)
 - a. In a timely manner, the licensee shall provide to the Commission a description of its practices on employee's self-identifying for the purposes of showing progress or success towards its Diversity Plan.
