5. The licensees, when applicable, have been inspected over the previous year. Commission staff certify that, to the best of our knowledge, no information has been found that would prevent renewal of the licenses mentioned above pursuant to 935 CMR 500.450.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Commission staff recommend review and decision on the above-mentioned licenses applying for renewal, and if approved, request that the approval be subject to the licensee remaining in compliance with the Commission regulations and applicable law.

The following licensees must comply with additional conditions:

- 1.) CommCan, Inc. (#MRR205788) (#MRR205801)
  - a. Within 90 days the licensee shall provide notification to the Commission, clarification on how a donation to the Food Pantry in Mills encourages full participation in the regulated cannabis industry by individuals from communities disproportionately harmed by cannabis prohibition and enforcement and to positively impact those communities under M.G.L. c. 94G, § 4 in Massachusetts. While establishments may donate to organizations of their choice, when choosing an organization to donate to for inclusion in their plan to impact disproportionate people and communities, this is a gentle reminder to please be cautious, mindful, and intentional to ensure that such donations are in line with the Mission of the CCC.
  - a. Within 90 days, the licensee shall submit to the Commission, an amended Diversity Plan that provides measurable outcomes for goals one (1) and two (2) as it relates to M.G.L. c. 94G, § 4 in Massachusetts.

Within 90 days the applicant shall submit to the Commission, an updated Positive Impact Plan that provides measurable outcomes for the webinar that was conducted, as it relates to your goal of “25 people attending and whether feedback received from evaluations of individual attending the training was higher than 80%”.

3.) I.N.S.A., Inc. (#MRR205775)

- a. Within 90 days submit to the Commission, an amended Positive Impact Plan that provides an update on whether the four (4) scholarships have been awarded.
