No entities, other than the applicant, appear to have ownership or control interests over the proposed Medical Marijuana Dispensary.

6. Applicant's information pertaining to co-located operations:

The applicant will not be co-located with an adult-use marijuana establishment.



7. The applicant and municipality executed a Host Community Agreement on November 14, 2018.
8. The Commission received a municipal response from the municipality on March 4, 2019 stating the applicant was in compliance with all local ordinances and bylaws.

9. There were no concerns arising from background checks on the individuals or entities associated with the application.
10. There were no disclosures of any past civil or criminal actions, or occupational license issues.

MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS REVIEW

11. The applicant states that it can be operational by January 2020.
12. The applicant was not required to submit proposed hours of operation. Commission staff will obtain this information during inspection.
13. The applicant submitted all applicable and required summaries of procedures for the operation of the proposed Medical Marijuana Treatment Center. The summaries were determined to be substantially compliant with the Commission's regulations.

14. Summary of cultivation plan:

The applicant submitted a summary of a cultivation plan that demonstrated the ability to comply with the regulations of the Commission.

15. Summary of products to be produced and/or sold (if applicable):
 - a. Dissolving tablets;
 - b. Tinctures;
 - c. Sprays;
 - d. Ready-to-use extracted hash oils;
 - e. Pre-dissolved oil vaporizers;
 - f. Capsules;
 - g. Cooking oils;
 - h. Edibles; and
 - i. Beverages.



RECOMMENDATION

Commission staff recommend provisional licensure with the following conditions:

1. Final license is subject to inspection to ascertain compliance with Commission regulations;
2. Final license is subject to inspection to ascertain compliance with applicable state laws and local codes, ordinances, and bylaws;
3. The applicant shall cooperate with and provide information to Commission staff;
4. Provisional licensure is subject to the payment of the appropriate license fee; and
5. Final licensure is subject to the licensee providing Commission staff with a specific list of edible products that will be produced.

The applicant has demonstrated compliance with the laws and regulations of the Commonwealth and suitability for licensure. Therefore, the applicant is recommended for provisional licensure.
