

Medical Use of Marijuana Program: New Patients

To register as a new Patient in Massachusetts, you must:

- Get certified by a Certifying Healthcare Provider;
- Have a valid ID;
- Be a resident of Massachusetts;
- Apply online via the Online Portal at MassCannabisControl.com.

In order to purchase medical marijuana, Patients must maintain an active certification from a Certifying Healthcare Provider and registration with the Commission's Medical Use of Marijuana Program.



FACT

If you're a resident of Massachusetts and have a qualifying medical condition, you may be eligible to register with the Massachusetts Medical Use of Marijuana Program.

Qualifying Medical Conditions

Before registering with the Program, you must receive a written recommendation from a Certifying Healthcare Provider that identifies your qualifying medical condition.

Qualifying Medical Conditions May Include:

- Cancer
- Glaucoma
- HIV/AIDS
- Hepatitis C
- Lou Gehrig's disease (ALS)
- Crohn's disease
- Parkinson's disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Other debilitating conditions as determined in writing by a Certifying Healthcare Provider



Once you have been certified by a Certifying Healthcare Provider, you will receive an email from the Commission that includes a four-digit PIN registration number and instructions for completing the Patient application online.
