

Medical Use of Marijuana Program in Massachusetts

Massachusetts residents with qualifying medical conditions may be eligible to register as Patients for the Medical Use of Marijuana Program.

State-licensed Medical Marijuana Treatment Centers (MTCs) offer safe, tested products with clear labeling for Patients, and medical products may be purchased tax-free for Patients' use under Massachusetts law.

In-person and telehealth consultations with Certifying Healthcare Providers are available for first-time and renewing Patients, making access easier than ever. Once certified, Patients may register for the Cannabis Control Commission's Medical Use of Marijuana Program.



FACT

From January 2019 to June 2024, MTCs have generated approximately \$1.3 billion in medical sales, serving more than 90,000 Patients and 6,500 Caregivers.

Know the Rules About Possessing and Consuming Medical Marijuana in Massachusetts.

- You cannot use medical marijuana in any form—including smoking, vaping, or eating—in public places or on federal land.
- You must carry your Program registration card whenever you are in possession of marijuana for medical use.
- The maximum amount a Patient may possess at one time is a 60-day supply—or up to 10 ounces.
- Patients or Caregivers can grow and maintain up to 12 flowering and 12 vegetative plants for personal medical use.
- Only Massachusetts Patients or their Caregivers may purchase products from licensed MTCs in the Commonwealth.
- Always store cannabis in secure, childproof packaging to prevent accidental ingestion.

Please note:

It's illegal to drive across state lines with any kind of medical marijuana product. It's also against the law to transport it on a plane, train, boat, or other mode of transportation outside of Massachusetts.
