Marijuana in Massachusetts

Know the Law

- You have to be 21 or older to buy or use marijuana of any kind, with exceptions for patients in the Medical Use of Marijuana Program.
- Any marijuana use is not allowed in public or on federal lands.
- Landlords, employers, and municipalities may have their own policies about the use, sale, or growth of cannabis.
- Don't drive if you've been using marijuana.
- You can have up to one ounce on you, and grow six plants in your home – or up to 12 with two or more adults.



BE SAFE

If you have been using marijuana, have a **designated driver** or arrange alternative transportation.

IMPORTANT PRODUCT INFO

Warning Labels: Marijuana sold through state-certified adult-use retail shops will have two warning labels on the package.



Higher Potency: Marijuana products sold today are much more potent than in the past.

More Varieties: Marijuana is available in a wider variety of products, including edible foods and liquids.

It can take several hours before the effect of edibles kicks in.

LOCK IT UP

If you have marijuana in your home, lock it up and keep out of reach of children and pets.
